



Brimfield Police Department Accomplishments & Projects Completed Since Last Police Safety Levy

1. Achieved agency certification through the OCJS Ohio Police-Community Collaborative for meeting established statewide law enforcement policy standards.
2. Partnered with Field Local Schools for a new 3-year School Resource Officer Program Agreement beginning in 2020.
3. Sgt. John Pettit selected by the Portage County Police Chief's Association as *Portage County Crisis Intervention Training Officer of the Year*.
4. Officer Matthew Kennedy selected by the Portage County Police Chief's Association as *Portage County Crisis Intervention Training Officer of the Year*.
5. Implemented a new body worn camera program in 2017, with original equipment purchase supplemented through JAG-LE Grant funds.
6. Final BPD Supervisor completed the Supervisor Training and Education Program (STEP) and the Police Executive Leadership College (PELC) through the Ohio Association of Chiefs of Police, Law Enforcement Foundation. All BPD supervisors have completed this training regimen.
7. Implemented a secure online *Vacation House Watch* portal program accessible through our agency website for our residents.
8. Implemented web-based community crime mapping resource accessible through our agency website for our residents.
9. Utilized grant programs through the Ohio Attorney General's office and the Department of Justice to supplement body armor funding for our officers.
10. Upgraded all agency in-car and portable radios to the state of Ohio MARCS platform, providing county-wide agency interoperability and significantly enhancing officer safety.
11. Upgraded all BPD cruisers with new HD in-car video camera systems.
12. Upgraded the agency server system to replace outdated technology.
13. Upgraded all cruiser mobile computers that were mostly older, refurbished units with new ruggedized tablets.

14. School Resource Officer Brett Dinkelman achieved accreditation through the Ohio School Resource Officer Association as a **Master SRO** based upon his ongoing training.
15. Sgt. David Knarr now serves as a Training Coordinator for Buckeye Area Regional K-9 (BARK), a regional police K-9 training group.
16. Funded a new mobile speed awareness monitoring trailer for our community.
17. Added a 2nd BPD Officer to serve on our regional Portage-Summit Metro SWAT Team.
18. Officer John Pettit promoted to position of Sergeant.
19. Replaced our aging K-9 police cruiser with a new vehicle. New K-9 Recon brought on board following the retirement of K-9 Havoc.
20. Implemented an annual cruiser fleet rotation program to keep maintenance costs reasonable and preventing the need to replace a large number of vehicles at one time.
21. Implemented *Nixle* community notification messaging system for our residents in partnership with the Board of Trustees.
22. BPD Policy Manual revised, and a monthly policy training program implemented for our officers.
23. Introduced online training through *Police One Academy* as a supplement to annual police officer training.
24. Added a 3rd Admin. Asst. position to our staff, providing an additional customer service presence for our residents.
25. Introduced a UAV (drone) Program for our Brimfield safety forces with 4 BPD Officers trained and certified as licensed operators.
26. Introduced an updated smartphone App for the Brimfield Police Department (*MyPD*).
27. Supplemented budget dollars by utilizing grant opportunities through Ohio Homeland Security, the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Walmart, the Ohio Township Association, NOPEC, and the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services.
28. 3 BPD Officers trained and certified as Crime Prevention Specialists through the Ohio Crime Prevention Association. 2 BPD Officers trained and certified as Scenario Based Training Instructors through the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy. 1 BPD Officer trained and certified as De-escalation Instructor. Multiple BPD Officers trained and certified as Field Training Officers through the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy.

29. Chief Roy Mosley III selected to serve as Chairman of the Education Committee of the Ohio Association of Chiefs of Police. Captain Christopher Adkins selected to serve on the Executive Board of the Police Executive Leadership College for the Ohio Association of Chiefs of Police, Law Enforcement Foundation.
30. Implemented annual Crisis Intervention Training (CIT) training schedule, with all BPD Officers now having completed the program/scheduled to attend.
